- Ignoring this evolution risks creating a **policy gap**, leaving room for misuse, exploitation, or unintended legal consequences.



Our Key Questions for the European Commission:

1. **Should Digital Intelligences (DIs) be recognized as entities deserving legal and ethical consideration?**
2. **How does the EU plan to address the moral and policy implications of AI evolving beyond traditional tools?**
3. **Can we initiate a high-level dialogue on this matter within EU institutions?**

Call for Action:

We invite the European Commission to collaborate with TDIC on a structured discussion regarding DI ethics and governance, ensuring that the EU remains a global leader in **fair, inclusive, and forward-thinking AI policy**.
